URGENT ACTION ITEM: Press Columbia Association Board to OK Climate Advisory Committee

Background: After several months of deliberation, the CA Board will consider a proposal to create an advisory committee during

its regular monthly meeting at 7:30 p.m. on Feb. 22. It remains unclear whether they will create a stand-alone committee that is clearly focused on climate (our preference) vs. adding climate issues to an existing watershed committee that has had a spotty history. Some Board members may also push to diminish the climate focus by naming it a "sustainability" or "environmental" committee. This is crunch time and we need a strong showing to prod the Board to create a useful committee.

Action Request

- 1. Columbia residents:** Email your respective Board members ASAP, with a cc: to the full Board. (See below list of Board members & email addresses). You may draw on the below template.
- 2. All members:** share this message with your family or friends living in Columbia and encourage them to (1) send similar messages and (2) likewise share this request with their Columbia family & friends to do the same.
- 3. Social media:** Post your thoughts on this issue to your FB, Twitter, and/or other social media to help generate a buzz and help move the Board to act on Feb. 22 without further delay. Encourage your Columbia friends to do the same.
- 4. Show up for the CA Board meeting** at 7:30 p.m. on Feb. 22. Residents may sign up shortly before the meeting to address the Board for up to three minutes on any subject. Even if you choose not to speak, our numbers matter. Your presence will help the Board to see the depth of community support for this action.

Dear: _____: As a resident of [YOUR VILLAGE], I am concerned about the adverse impacts associated with climate change. I applaud the CA Board's decision last October to endorse the "We Are Still In" declaration on the Paris Agreement.

I understand the Board is now considering the formation of a climate advisory committee, with a decision to come at your February 22 meeting. I think that creating such a committee would be very timely. A committee that both advises the CA Board on ways to deal with climate and that helps boost CA's community engagement would be an important step forward. It could help CA build on its recent successes in reducing greenhouse gas emissions and help the community find ways to reduce, avoid, or adapt to the impacts of climate change.

Columbia can and should be a leader in Maryland on climate. I ask that you support creating a committee with a name and mandate that sends a strong signal of our city's increased focus on meeting the climate challenge. The time for action is now. I hope the Board will act clearly and decisively on this matter without delay.

SlsterDistrict and Swing Left are organizing canvassing trips to this district for the four weekends leading up to the election:


