- 1. Read read the Conor Lamb phone bank instructions. These can be used as a handout if you are phonebanking with a group.
- 2. Click on link: https://www.openvpb.com/vpb bycode/FD7542G-935965
- 3. Register for for an ActionID account (if you haven't previously).
- 4. A screen will appear with voter's name and phone number. Call the phone number and read the script provided.
- 5. If you get a voicemail, please mark "I couldn't reach (voter)" so we can try to reach them in person later.
- 6. If you are concerned about using your phone number or would like to choose a local area code (724), you could use the Google Voice app (but this is NOT a requirement). Here's how:
