A RALLY TO REMEMBER THE MASSACRE AT THE PULSE NIGHTCLUB





JUNE 12th, TWO YEARS AFTER THE MASSACRE AT THE PULSE NIGHTCLUB, STUDENTS AND LGBTQ ACTIVISTS ARE PLANNING A DIE-IN.

On the second anniversary of the Pulse Nightclub shooting a group of student activists from across the nation will hold a National Die-In to honor those who have been lost, and to fight for common sense gun control. The rally in DC is planned to take place on the lawn of the capital and will begin at 10:30. At noon we will promptly drop to the ground and participate in a Die-In that will last 12 minutes, 720 seconds. This number represents the approximate number of people who have died in a mass shooting since the Pulse Nightclub Massacre. Our bodies will symbolize the tangible effects that lethal legislative inaction has on its citizens. Our main Die-In will be in Washington DC, and we plan to host people from across the nation. However, if you are not able to come we encourage sister Die-Ins to happen all over the nation. In government buildings, state Capitols, elected official's offices, and NRA recipient buildings. Our website will be up in the coming days including a platform to register events. Together we will end lethal legislation.
