"Changing what was considered normal behavior and what was cool played a critical role," said Matthew Myers, a Washington lawyer who has been fighting Big Tobacco for decades. And he sees the parallels with gun culture.

"Changing the social norm about the risk of guns in our communities needs to be part of the debate. When kids are afraid to go to school; parents are afraid to let their kids go to the playground or sit on the porch — the freedom to own guns is impinging on the basic rights of innocent citizens."





This week, Virginia's General Assembly passed a budget including Medicaid expansion. When Democratic Governor Ralph Northam signs it into law, Virginia will become the 34th state to accept Medicaid expansion. As a result, over 300,000 Virginians will now have health coverage under the policy. This is possible because of your work last summer and fall, knocking on doors and making phone calls to flip seats in Virginia. The candidates you worked to elect are now the delegates casting deciding votes on Medicaid expansion. We've got a chance this fall to flip even more seats and ensure smart decent policy for the rest of the country. Let's get to work!
