

ACTIONS



After two days of intense questioning from Democrats on the Judiciary Committee, Supreme Court Justice nominee Brett Kavanaugh only further proved to us that our rights and democracy are in danger.

Here are three things we learned from Kavanaugh's confirmation hearing:

- He refused to commit to upholding Roe v. Wade.
- 2 He refused to say whether he believes a president must comply with a subpoena.
- He refused to reveal whether he has discussed the Mueller investigation with people in Trump's orbit.

On top of all of that, documents from Kavanaugh's time in the Bush White House published by the New York Times on Thursday revealed that Kavanaugh believes that the Supreme Court can overturn Roe v. Wade. AND it appears he perjured himself during his prior confirmation hearings for DC's Circuit Court of Appeals in 2004 and 2006. This confirms, and puts into the public record, what we already knew: Brett Kavanaugh is utterly unfit to sit on the Supreme Court, and every Senator should vote no on his nomination.

We can still #StopKavanaugh, but it won't be easy.

Thanks to your calls, Cardin publicly committed to vote against Kavanaugh on August 7. See <u>press release</u>. But we need more votes.

Please send emails to all the Senators listed under the "waffle" category. You can find their names and the emails for the staff assigned to this issue on the <u>SCOTUS Tracker</u>. Demand that they vote no on Brett Kavanaugh's nomination to the Supreme Court. We still have a chance to prevent this disaster.

ELECTIONS- MARYLAND

Proof that door-knocking works in Howard County!

In spring 2018, the IndivisibleHoCoMD Red2Blue Team formed a coalition with several other groups in the County to knock on doors in one precinct (5-04) that had a low turn out in the 2014 mid-term to see if they could improve turnout for the June Primary simply by talking to voters and reminding them about the election. In April we were seeking unregistered voters and in May we turned to election awareness. The data is finally in and the answer is YES-Door-Knocking works. Democratic primary turnout increased across the county, but the increase in Precinct 5-04 was 15 percentage points higher than the county average.

If a handful of volunteers could do that in one precinct, think what all of us could do across the county. Please show up for Team Howard County's **Commit to Vote** canvasses, going door to door reminding and energizing voters. We have been getting a great reception – people are happy to get information about voting dates and places and to see that someone is doing something.




In addition to the survey responses on immigration from candidates for County Council, our website now has responses from candidates for State Senator and Delegates. Find it here.
