Call Day In support of Voting Rights - Wednesday, Feb 28th

This Wednesday, February 28th, is our "Call Day" in support of Maryland voting rights, specifically, SB1048 - Secure and Accessible Registration Act (SARA). Please take a few minutes during the day on Wednesday

to call your state senator and ask them to support this bill which is being considered during the current legislative session and will be dicsussed during the Edcuation, Health, and Environmental Affairs (EHE) Committee Hearing on Thursday, March 1. Secure and Accessible Registration Act (SARA) – currently, when Marylanders interact with covered agencies (Motor Vehicle Administration, Maryland Health Benefit Exchange, local departments of social services, etc.) they must go through a separate step to re-input their data in order to register to vote. This bill will streamline that process and change it from an "optin" process to an "opt-out" process.

The Senate Hearing for SB1036 is this Wednesday (2/28) in Annapolis. Call your Maryland State Senator before Wednesday asking them to support SB 1036, a bill that will save Marylanders' lives by disarming convicted domestic abusers. SB 1036 requires a court to inform a defendant convicted of a certain offense that the defendant is prohibited from possessing a certain firearm under certain provisions of law.
