The meeting kicked off with a review of our many successes and a few misses during the 2018 Maryland legislative session. Then Senator Van Hollen spoke about what we as active citizens can do to make a difference. While we need to push back on all the bad actions out of the Trump White House, he urged us to also promote all the positive things we stand for including:

- \* Campaign Finance Reform
- \* Realistic Pharmaceutical Costs
- \* Fighting Climate Change
- \* Returning Penalty Fees for Pollution to the American People
- \* Debt-Free College
- \* Reforming the Criminal Justice System.

Achieving these goals depends on getting progressives elected. The Democrats have 26 Senators up for re-election. To achieve a majority, Democrats need to win in all those Senate races as well as flip two Republican seats. Supporting Mueller's investigation is important, but pushing for impeachment energizes Trump's base and distracts from the real work that needs to be done - registering new voters and encouraging people to vote through canvassing, postcards, and phonecalls. Concluding, Van Hollen said grassroots efforts like ours are responsible for most major changes in the political environment.

#### **EDUCATION UPDATE**

The Kirwan Commission is working to bring Maryland's public education system back to the top and to set a standard for

the nation by establishing a new funding formula. All children deserve the best we have to offer and the Kirwan Recommendations are a most useful start. Chair Brit Kirwan explains the Kirwan Commission recommendations in a 10 minute video interview with the Baltimore Sun.

#### **Kirwan's Top 5 priorities:**

- 1. Early childhood education for all 4 year olds and for 3 year olds in poverty
- 2. Invest more in schools with high concentrations of poverty and special needs students
- 3. Significantly boost the level of the teaching profession by increasing standards and increasing salaries
- 4. School curriculum bench-marked against international standards, High Schools adding strong career and technical tracks
- 5. Accountability for the funding


