Postcard Brigade



The Postcard Brigade has been doing amazing things. Within 24 hours of announcing a new campaign, Brigadiers committed to 900 postcards being written to Iowa Democrats who had been ousted from the rolls. Thus far, they have committed to writing more than 1800 postcards to support Tom Suozzi (pronounced Swazzi) in the NY-03 election to replace George Santos, and they are still requesting addresses!

They again stepped to the plate and committed to 510 letters going to the NY-03 District to help young voters within Democratic households register to vote or to request their absentee The postcard brigade facilitators work with numerous organizations that are all working on our common goal of electing Dems. Along with campaigns for specific candidates who have been identified by the locals as having a fighting chance, there are projects to get out the vote (GOTV), register and re-register folks, and inform voters. We will announce projects as we discover worthwhile campaigns, and we cannot anticipate when they will occur. Defend Democracy

The Defend Democracy Team had their first meeting of the year on January 10th. We will be meeting every <u>2 weeks on Wednesdays at 7:00 pm</u> for the duration of the Maryland Legislative Session. To check the dates, click <u>here</u>. **And we've added a new member!**

We have started tracking some key elections bills and have meetings set up with a number of legislators. We continue to work with a number of coalitions as well and have recently connected with the group Rank the Vote. Some of the bills we are following involve local campaign finance, ranked choice voting, enhanced automatic voter registration, voting rights restoration, and lowering the voter registration age. We are also meeting and looking for support of a new bill on ballot eligibility. Although there are requirements for running for office, there is no official procedure in place to assure that.

We are grateful to Senators Lam and Hester and Delegates Wu and Terrasa for their work on bills involving ranked choice voting and campaign finance. We have good working relationships with these legislators as well as with Delegate Feldmark.

Stay tuned for more information about ranked choice voting. We are hoping to host a webinar to educate both the public and our legislators on its qualities and mechanism.
